CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAMS: SECONDARY CREDIT COURSES

The Toronto Catholic District School Board offers summer credit courses under the OSS curriculum guidelines. Parents and students must consult with their day school guidance counsellor regarding their course selections, prerequisite courses and diploma requirements. Course selections must be made in accordance with the Ontario Ministry of Education curriculum guidelines. Diploma requirements are listed on the Ontario Ministry of Education Web site: www.edu.gov.on.ca

TYPES OF COURSES

NEW CREDIT COURSES: These courses enable students to obtain a full credit toward their diploma in a subject that was not previously taken. New credit courses are scheduled for 6 hours daily. In combination with an eClass Online Learning course, students may register for a maximum of two new credit courses. For course descriptions, please visit our website.

UPGRADING COURSES: These courses enable students who have not been successful during the regular school year to obtain one full credit by repeating 57 hours of instruction. Students wishing to improve a passing mark may also take these courses. Each class is scheduled for approximately 3 hours daily either morning or afternoon, thus enabling students to enrol in one or two upgrading courses. Students should have a minimum mark of 35% to enrol in an upgrading course. Grade 12 Courses - 4U/4M courses, students require a minimum mark of 45% in order to upgrade. Students can enrol in a maximum of two upgrading credit courses for the duration of the program.

TRANSFER COURSES: These are partial credit courses that bridge the gap between courses of two types in the same subject and different levels. Transfer courses are available at the grade 9 & 10 & 11 level. See chart on page 2.

COURSE FEES

A consumables fee of \$20.00 cash for new credit courses and \$10.00 cash for upgrading credit courses is payable by all students on the first session of classes. The consumables fee for eClass courses is payable at the mandatory session (see eClass section for details).

International students must register in person at the Catholic Education Center, 80 Sheppard Avenue East (Sheppard Ave. E & Yonge St.). Please call 416-222-8282 ext. 2675 for an appointment and additional information. Additional course fees are applicable.

DATES AND TIMES

All courses run from **Monday, June 29, 2009 through to Monday, July 27, 2009.** New credit courses are ALL day - scheduled from **8:30 a.m. to 3:15 p.m.**

Upgrading AM sessions are scheduled from **8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.**

Upgrading PM sessions are scheduled from **12:15 p.m. to 3:15 p.m.**

Allocation of students to morning or afternoon sessions is at the discretion of the summer school principal.

Final exam date: Thursday, July 23, 2009.

Exam Review/Student Success Day: Friday, July 24. On the student success day, students will have an opportunity to review and to submit outstanding assignments
Report card pickup & Final mark review day : Monday, July 27, 2009 between 9 a.m to 11 a.m.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

TCDSB students will only be able to register through their day school guidance counsellors from **Monday, May 11, 2009 until Thursday, June 25, 2009.** Based on enrolment, courses will be cancelled or redirected on **June 24th.** Students may register for a maximum of two upgrading credits or two new credit courses (in combination with an online eClass course).

To Register:

1. Students must submit a completed registration form to their day school guidance counsellors who will register them.
2. A copy of the registration form and a Continuing Ed. timetable print-out will be returned to the students indicating that they have been registered.
3. Students must present this copy of the registration form, Continuing Ed. timetable print-out and a consumables fee on the first day of classes. (See Course Dates.) Students taking eClass courses must submit these items at the Mandatory Session. See eClass Mandatory Session for more information.

Note that the **deadline for registration is Thursday, June 25, 2009** at your Guidance Dept. Registration form are only available through your Guidance Dept.
Note*: There will be **NO ON SITE REGISTRATION.**

Non-TCDSB students can request to apply for a maximum of two upgrading credits or two new credit courses (in combination with eClass online course). Students requesting courses online will be placed on a waiting list and notified by email if space is available. The online course request site will open on **Wednesday, May 13, 2009 at 5 p.m.** Student requests will be prioritized based on the date of the online submission.

ACCEPTANCE: Students that request a course online may receive an acceptance email any day starting on **June 12th up to the start of the program.** Details will be outlined in the acceptance email sent to students. Adult learners experiencing technical difficulties with applying online may register in person on Thursday, June 18 anytime between 2 p.m. and 7 p.m. at our Continuing Education Department located at 80 Sheppard Ave. East.

Grade 8 students registering for a grade 9 credit course can do so by obtaining a Summer School Credit Course Registration form from their local TCDSB school.

Grade 8 students must complete the registration form and obtain approval from their September Secondary school. **They must obtain a guidance signature and school stamp in order to register for a summer school course.** A copy of the approved and completed registration form will be returned to the student.

The September secondary school will forward the approved registration form to: Continuing Education Dept - Summer School, C.E.C., 80 Sheppard Ave. East, Toronto, Ontario M2N 6E8.

Deadline: The Continuing Education Department must receive all approved registration forms by **Wed., June 17.** Students requesting a course are asked to attend the first day of class along with a photocopy of their registration form and the consumable fee.

Attendance for the first class confirms the student's registration and secures the registrants' place in that class. Students, who do not attend the first day of class, forfeit their place in the class and will be placed on the waiting list. Due to the concentrated nature of summer school courses, regular attendance and punctuality are mandatory. Parents must contact the summer school location during summer school hours to report or to inquire about their child's attendance.

EVALUATION

All students will be required to write a final exam. Students that are unable to fulfill this condition will be considered not to have completed the course.

PLEASE NOTE: The final opportunity to review and discuss summer school results is on **Monday, July 27, 2009 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.**

DISTRIBUTION OF REPORT CARDS

Report cards will distributed at the summer school on **Monday, July 27 between 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.**

TCDSB Students: A copy of the final report card will be forwarded to the home school of all TCDSB students.

NON-TCDSB Students: Report cards must be picked up at their summer school location. Students must submit their report card to their home school or transcript office. Contact your school board or guidance dept., regarding this procedure.

CLOSING OF CLASSES

The TCDSB reserves the right to cancel or relocate a class. Classes that are cancelled or relocated will be posted on our website on **Wednesday, June 24th after 6 p.m.** at: <http://www.tcdsb.org/continuinged/cancellations.htm>

It is the student's responsibility to check on **Wednesday, June 24th** for all cancelled and relocated classes.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: ECLASS COURSES

Note that the deadline for eClass registration is **Friday, June 19, 2009.** If space is available, students will be able to register through their day school guidance counsellors the week of June 22nd.

In addition to registering online, accepted students will receive an email to attend a registration evening on **Wednesday, June 17 or on Thursday, June 18 anytime between 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.** at the Continuing Education Department - 80 Sheppard Ave East. Details will be outlined in the email. Accepted students must also attend their scheduled two hour Mandatory Session.

***No emails are sent to students regarding their session day and time.**

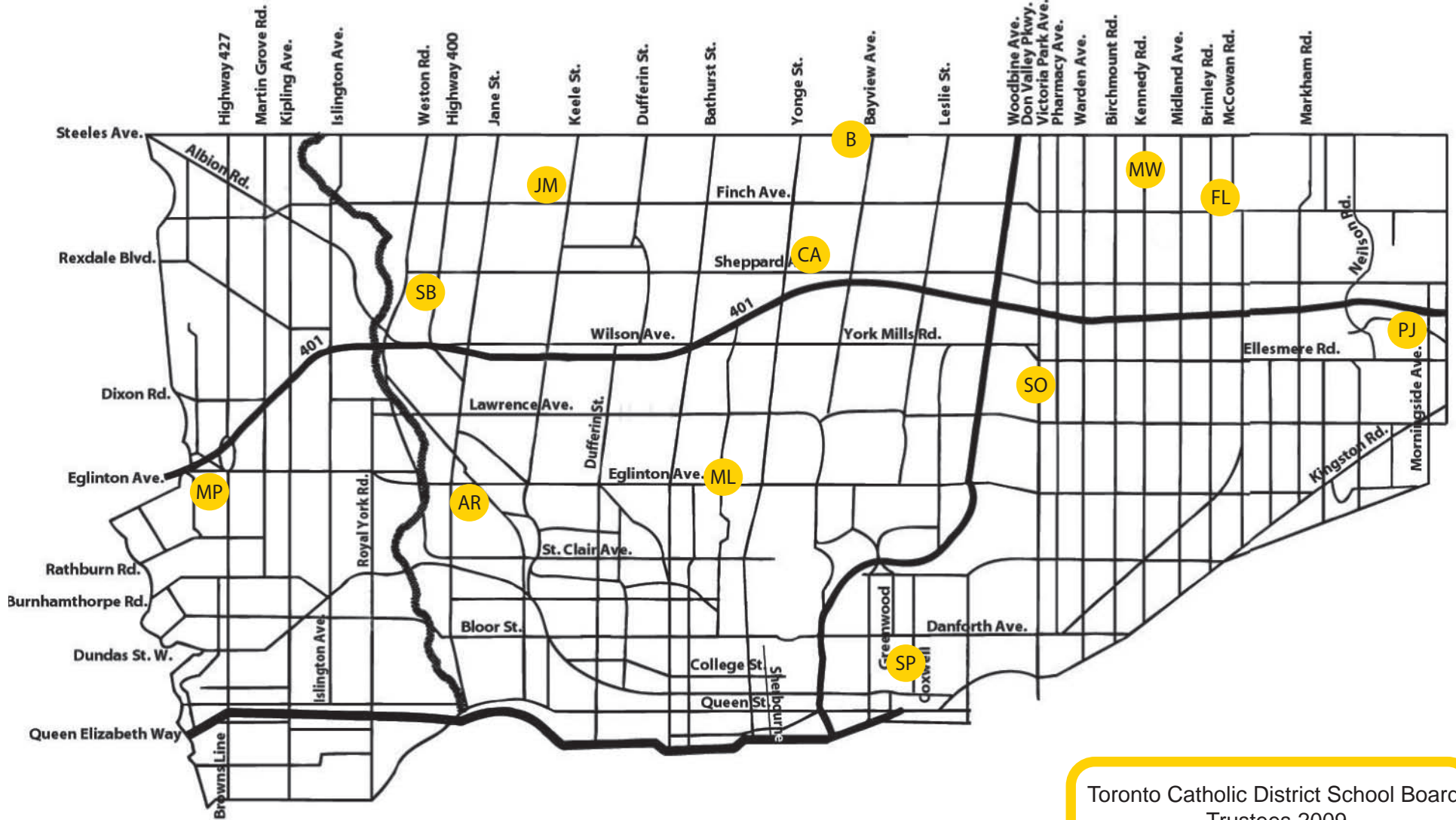
