St. Pius X Catholic Elementary School Community

Dear Parents and Staff:

I am pleased to provide an update on the proposed St. Pius X Catholic School addition. On March 26, 2010 Toronto Catholic District School Board received approval from the Ministry of Education for the St. Pius X addition of six classrooms, four kindergartens in the existing school and a general office near the new front entrance. Pending formal Municipal approvals, the Board can issue construction tenders for this project.

The Board is responsible for any costs in excess of the approved capital budget. If tenders for the project are higher than the approved budget, the Board is required to seek further approval from the Ministry of Education and the Board must identify additional sources of revenue to offset any higher costs.

The Board is awaiting formal Municipal approvals including site plan approval, building permit. We anticipate that construction could start in late summer 2010. Construction is expected to take approximately 12 months.

At the April 28, 2010 meeting of The Ministry Supervisor (The Board) approval was given for the temporary (partial) relocation of St. Pius to the closed portion of St. Vincent de Paul Catholic. The relocation of St. Pius X is scheduled for start of the school year 2010-2011 or September 2010. Further details outlining bussing and school schedules will be provided as soon as these details are confirmed.

The Board endeavours to minimize the disruption to the school communities impacted during this period of growth. We ask you to focus on the long-term benefits to all students in our system once the construction is complete. We look forward to your participation in the consultation process.

I wish to thank the St. Pius X Catholic School Community for their continuing support for Catholic Education.
