### Father Henry Carr Turns Sod on “Field of Dreams”

The Toronto Catholic District School Board is proud to announce the groundbreaking ceremony for a new playing field and track at Father Henry Carr Catholic Secondary in North Etobicoke. The ceremony takes place at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, June 11<sup>th</sup> at 1760 Martin Grove Road in Etobicoke.

Thanks in large part to the overwhelming support of both MP Kirsty Duncan and MPP Shafiq Qaadri, funding commitments from the Federal and Provincial Governments and fundraising efforts by the school community, the school will be breaking ground on its “Field of Dreams.”

Phase one of the project would include the creation of an artificial-turf field, 6 lane rubberized track and rough-ins for night lighting and scoreboard.

Father Henry Carr has a long history of athletic success in a variety of sports disciplines. Other athletic organizations in the community will also have access to the new playing field on weekends and evenings during the school year.
