Installation: Header of banner placed against railing of Atrium and balance (blank writing area) over a table so it would be easier to write on it.

Report:

The banner was well made and very impressive in size, style and finish. It did get the attention of most attendees when they first arrived but they did not write on it at that point. It seems this was because they were not aware of what it was or what exactly to do with it. One or two did add their input at the beginning of the conference on their own accord, however, most of the input was received after an announcement was made directing attendees to add their comments/ideas. And then people were actually checking input posted by others. Once people got their banners it was well received and the feedback was very positive. A notice about the banner was also included on the back of the program notice given to attendees.

Recommendation:

A person should be stationed near the banner to direct/help people add their input. But this may not be necessary in the future once people have been exposed enough to this initiative. And the banner should be used by CPIC members when they attend special events and/or meetings with their schools/parents. A lot of great input was received and should be documented and shared with all schools.
