We have arranged with Jeannette Finlayson from Acorn Custom Cards to meet with our teachers to discuss the custom card fundraising program. As mentioned in the last newsletter this is a project in which our students design their own cards and each child's original artwork is made into sets of 12 greeting cards which are then purchased by the child or family. This is a brand new fundraising idea that started up this year. Other schools in our area that participated in this program before Christmas gave it very positive reviews.
