Fundraising – Spring Raffle – A net balance of \$7,874 was collected from the spring raffle

Education – No update.

Safe School –

- i) Sick Policy was reviewed. It was clearly stated that a child is sent home if he/she is visibly uncomfortable (i.e. vomits, fever). The child's parent will be contacted and asked to pick up the child.
- ii) Fans – There are still a few fans that are not properly working. Eva and Margaret will be making the arrangements to return those that are not working to Costco.
- iii) Parking Issue on Hillmount Ave. – No volunteers came forward to set up a Kiss and Ride program.

Social/Spiritual – Year end BBQ is scheduled for June 12th. Plans are on going. This will also act as CSAC's official and final meeting for the school year 2006/07.

Principals Report –

- i) Mould – Representatives from the facilities dept. were at our school to inspect possible mould over the windows in the classrooms. Some was detected and cork above windows will be removed and replaced with a white wall surface.

- ii) Extra curricular activities going on in the school are:
 - Boy's Baseball for grades 7 and 8
 - Cross Country has a few students moving on to the Regionals and City Finals
 - Track and Field will take place on May 28th
 - WH5 participants (grade 7/8) came in 2nd out of 3 schools that participated

- iii) There is a Long Term Accommodation meeting at the CEC on June 4 from 7 - 9 P.M.

- iv) Cross Photo of the school generated \$240.25 profit. This money will be given to the school's ECO fund that will assist with the landscaping of the school property. We have also received help from organizations, such as, Earth Angels. Earth Rangers and the Toronto Clean up Event have been other events in our Eco School Phase.
