



SHARELIFE INDONESIA EARTHQUAKE RELIEF

On September 30, a massive earthquake rocked West Sumatra, Indonesia and hundreds of tremors were experienced for several days afterward. As of October 6, the United Nations reported nearly 750 confirmed dead with hundreds more still missing. More than 100,000 homes and buildings, including hospitals and health clinics, were reported destroyed. The extent of the damage continues to be assessed as many of the worst affected communities are in isolated areas.

The ShareLife Office is accepting donations to support disaster relief efforts in Indonesia, assisting in the provision of food, shelter, clean water, and medical and cooking supplies for those affected by the earthquake. Working through our relief partners, aid is being provided to victims while people struggle to cope with the effects of the disaster and work to rebuild their lives.
