

Free Adult English Classes will resume in September

The Adult Education Program reopens Tuesday, September 8th. Daytime English classes for newcomers start the week of September 8th. Evening and weekend English classes start the week of September 14th.

The Adult Education Program offers core LINC and ESL classes as well as special focus English classes such as workplace preparation (ELT, SLT), academic preparation (TOEFL), literacy and basic skills (LBS) and citizenship preparation. Newcomer settlement services (ISAP) and childminding & nursery services are also available in many school sites.

To register, learners must present two pieces of identification showing their status and proof of residence in Canada.
