



## Gymnasts return from meet with golds and silvers

Two North York gymnasts who are members of Markham Gymnastics came up with gold at the 2010 Men's Artistic Ontario Championships held in Burlington BGs Gymnastic Club from April 30 to May 2.

More than 150 male artistic gymnasts competed at the meet.

North York resident Kevin Hsiao, 15, got first all around. He took gold on floor, pommel horse and vault. He got silver on rings and bronze on the parallel and horizontal bars.

His win earned him a spot with the Ontario team, which will compete at the Canadian National Gymnastics Championships in Kamloops, BC at the end of May.

John Philip Chua, 12, a student at Holy Redeemer Catholic School in North York, won gold medals at the meet on the pommel horse, parallel bars and all around. He also won two silver on floor and horizontal bars.

Three other gymnasts from the same club who live in Markham also won medals at the meet.
