In partnership with the Literacy and Numeracy Secretariat, TCDSB is inviting applications for interested teachers for the position of **Student Work Study Teacher (Elementary/Secondary K-12)** – itinerant position (Intermediate/Senior qualifications required).

#### **Locations: Designated Schools**

#### **THE DUTIES OF THIS POSITION OF RESPONSIBILITY INCLUDE:**

- Assess samples of student work in relation to curriculum expectations and learning goals
- Determine the level of each student's work and describing precisely what the student needs to move the work to the next level
- Provide specific feedback and coaching to students as they improve their work
- Determine next steps in instruction
- Facilitate teacher moderation of student work in designated schools
- Promote strategies from Ministry resources including Effective Guides to Literacy and Mathematics, monographs, and web casts to assist teachers in developing tasks that result in high quality student work – tasks that incorporate the four categories of achievement (knowledge and understanding, critical and creative thinking, application, communications)
- Collect data regarding the impact of this student work initiative on student achievement in the designated schools

#### **CRITERIA FOR INTERVIEW:**

- Experienced in teacher moderation of student work
- Skilled in providing specific feedback to students and at designing instruction for higher order critical and creative thinking
- Knowledgeable about instruction and pedagogy in reading, writing and mathematics
- Respected as a facilitator of collegial professional learning
- Positive recommendation of current Principal

**NOTE: This position requires travelling between designated schools. The incumbents must have his/her own vehicle available to use and a valid Ontario driver's license.**
