Eligibility and Prizes

- Intermediate students (Grades 7-8) and secondary students of Toronto Catholic District School Board.
- The winning student will receive a **\$50.00 gift certificate**.
- The winning student will have his/her picture featured in Toronto Catholic District School Board's website. at: www.tcdsb.org
- The winning entry will become the TCDSB's poster brand for Asian Heritage Month, until further notice.
- The winning entry will become the program cover of 2013 Asian Heritage Month.

Poster Contest Guidelines:

- All artwork must be original. Any art medium can be used.
- The dimensions of the poster shall be 11x17 inches (27.9 x 43.2 cm).
- All entries must leave ample space for the logo of TCDSB.
- All entries must not contain photographs of any person(s).
- All entries must reflect and be inclusive of all Asian diaspora.
- All electronic entries can be submitted in .pdf or .jpeg format to leda.demariamiles@tcdsb.org. Please retain the hard copy of your artwork in case your entry is chosen.
- If submitting an original hard copy, please mail or send via internal courier to St. Richard School, Arts Department, 970 Bellamy Road, Toronto, M1H 1H1 c/o Leda Miles.
- All entries must include the attached information sheet.
- All entries should include an artist statement of their art piece.
- **All entries must be received by 4pm of March 22nd, 2013.**
- All entries will be evaluated based on the guideline criteria, visual aesthetics, and creativity.
