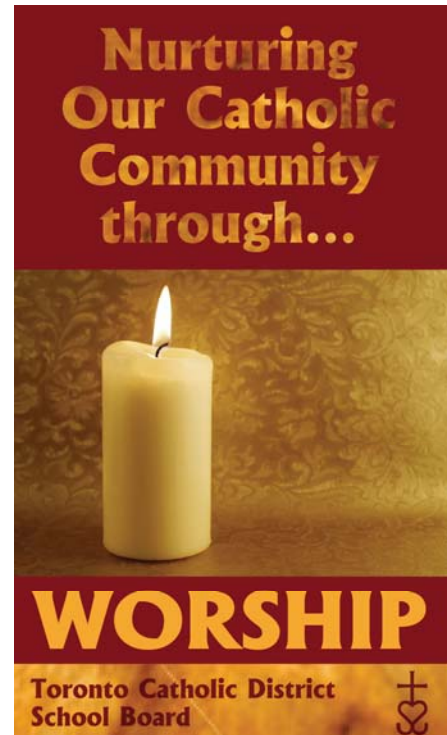


### Scripture Quotes on the Virtue of Charity
