## **The Catholic Community Award:**

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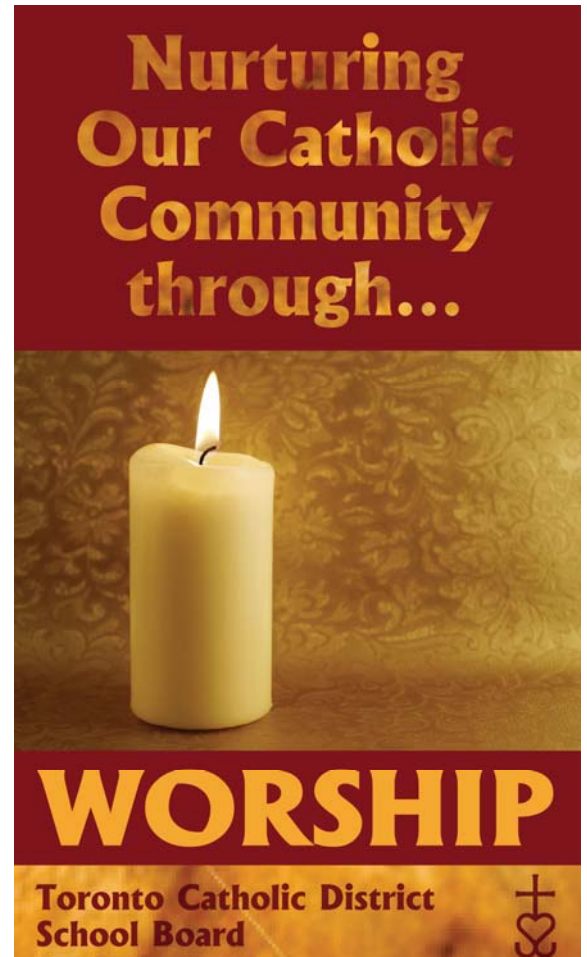

The Catholic Community Award is based on the monthly virtues. As a suggestion, you

may want to recognize these students in homeroom, at assemblies, during school liturgies, or in school newsletters, school websites. This can be a whole school project, a monthly initiative, or a nomination process by teachers and peers.

### **The Catholic Community Award: Criteria for the Virtue of Love**

- ✓ Students who offer support to peers in need
- ✓ Students who work in communion with others



- ✓ Students who demonstrate empathy toward others
- ✓ Students who show respect and recognize the contribution of others
- ✓ Students who give of themselves without the expectation of receiving anything in return
- ✓ Students who put themselves in “another person’s shoes” and care about this person’s feelings.
