How To Show Peace

Quote of the month – “Peace I leave to you, my peace I give to you” *John 14:27*

Song of the Month – *Prayer of St. Francis or Let there be peace on earth*

1. By opening ourselves to God, we will feel peace within us.

Skit 1 – God is good

Skit 3 – Using Christ’s peace to guide you

Students talking in class about world peace and then go out and start a fight in the yard (followed by the right way)
