

Networking for Employment (CLB 6)

A free online course for adult immigrants

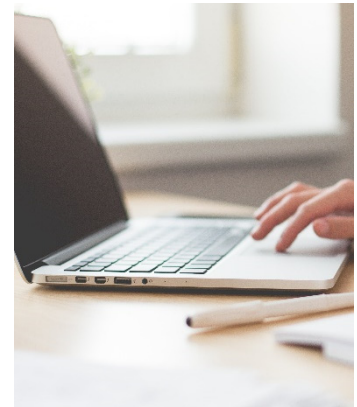


Networking is about making contacts, meeting people and building relationships that can lead to jobs.

In this online course, you will practise your English and learn about how and where to network.

About the Course

- It is completely online. You will work from home, on your own computer. There will be an online teacher assisting you during the course.
- It is 8 weeks long, from **Oct. 15 to Dec. 6, 2019**. You will spend about **4 hours a week** working on the course.



How to Register

If you are eligible (see box on right), you **must** have:

- A computer, with access to the internet and an active email account
- The ability to work independently, on your own
- Time to work on the course at least 4 hours a week
- An assessment from the YMCA that shows your English level is **CLB 5 or higher** in all four skills

NOTE: A language certificate will not be provided for this course.

You are eligible if your immigration status is:

- Refugee claimant OR
- Convention Refugee OR
- Permanent Resident OR
- Canadian Citizen OR
- Live-in Caregiver
