Citizenship preparation course
online?

With funding from Government of Ontario, we are looking for participants in **winter 2019**. Here is some information about the course:

You are eligible if your immigration status is:

- Refugee claimant **OR**
- Convention Refugee **OR**
- Permanent resident **OR**
- Live-in Caregiver

- This course is meant to be self-directed. That is you should be able to go through all the units on your own without help. However, we are there to help if you need it. We assume that you are able to work independently on your computer.
- You are expected to take an online mini course on how to sign up and login to an e-course, and complete assignments.
- Your English level (CLB) in listening, speaking, reading, and writing should be 5 and above.
- You are expected to follow the instructions that are outlined in the course space to help maximize your engagement in the course activities. You will learn about them after you have officially signed up.
- This course is offered during **January 7-March 29**. There are 12 units- some shorter (about 2-3 hours) and some longer (about 8-10 hours). It is expected that you complete all the units which will take about 60-80 hours. These units consist of many activities to familiarize you with the content required to pass the citizenship test.
- You can complete the units at your own time and pace and repeat the activities as many times as you like. There are quizzes, games, and a variety of readings to help you learn the material.
- There is an assessment task within each unit that you can only do ONCE.
- Once you complete all the units, we can send you your language certificate that you can submit with your citizenship application.

What do I need to register?

- A computer
- An active email account
- Access to internet from home
- Ability to work independently on your own
- Current assessment from the YMCA
