Since 2018, the Consulate General of the Republic of Poland in Toronto has invited Polish organizations, schools, parishes, scouts and individuals in the Toronto consular district (Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Nunavut) to jointly celebrate Polish culture, history and heritage of past generations under the common symbol and name “Polish Heritage Days”.

The “Polish Heritage Days” event is an opportunity to celebrate Poland with the wider community, by organizing open events, such as flag raising, music concerts, exhibitions, lectures, literary events, film screenings, folk festivals, culinary contests and many more.

It is also a way to tell about Polish contribution to the cultural, economic and social life of Canada, as well as to emphasize the positive role that the Polish community continues to play in Canada today.

The most important celebrations are the Day of the Polish Diaspora and Poles Abroad, the Polish National Flag Day on 2 May and the Constitution Day on 3 May. Nevertheless, all the initiatives aimed at celebrating Poland are welcome throughout the year as a component of Polish Heritage Days.
