CPIC is a provincially mandated and funded committee that supports student academic achievement through increased parent involvement. CPIC is a parent-led committee of volunteers who work locally and centrally to engage parents more fully in Catholic education.

CPIC's Committee Composition

- 24 Voting Parent Members: Ward Representatives - elected by parents (two-year term)
- 4 Voting Parent Members: At-Large- elected by 24 Parent Members (one-year term)
- 3 Community Voting Representatives - appointed by the committee
- Non-voting members: Trustee representative, Director of Education or Designate, Liaison Officer to the TCDSB
