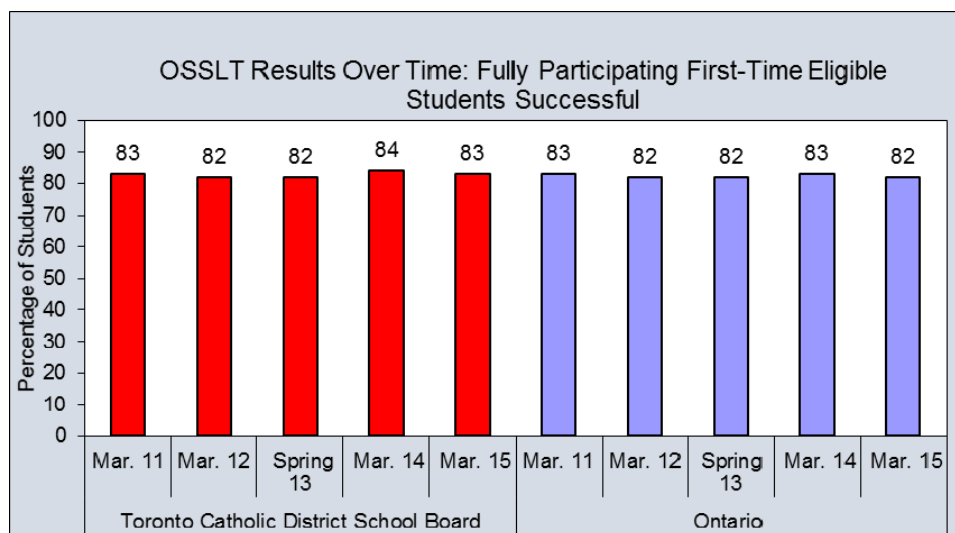
## 83% of High School Students Successful on Ontario Literacy Test

The Toronto Catholic District School Board is pleased to announce that 83% of its secondary school students were successful on the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test written last spring. This is consistent with the provincial average of 82%.

“We congratulate the students for their success, and the staff and parents who support their efforts,” says Director of Education Angela Gauthier. “As a Board, our focus continues to be on student achievement and well-being, and we recognize the partnership between our staff and our families in helping our students accomplish their academic goals.”

The results for TCDSB students over time have remained consistent, and have kept pace with provincial results as well.

“This is not to say that we can’t look for further improvements,” says the Director. “We are always seeking new and different methodologies that would benefit those students who traditionally do not perform well on standardized tests.”
