TD Scholarship for Community Leadership for Students

TD is committed to opening doors for a more inclusive and sustainable tomorrow, and creating conditions where everyone has the chance to succeed in a changing world. TD Scholarships are offered to students who, like TD, help support change, nurture progress and contribute to making the world a better place.

Each scholarship includes 4 years' tuition at any approved university or college in Canada for up to \$70,000* and opportunities for summer employment at TD. To be eligible, students must:

- Be capable of entering and completing university or college with a minimum average of 75%,
- Be in their last year of high school (outside Quebec) or
- Be in their last year of CEGEP (in Quebec).

Application deadline is November 16, 2018.
