The Toronto Catholic District School Board offers summer credit courses under the OSS curriculum guidelines. Parents and students must consult with their day school guidance counsellor regarding their course selections, prerequisite courses and diploma requirements. Course selections must be made in accordance with the Ontario Ministry of Education curriculum guidelines. Diploma requirements are listed on the Ontario Ministry of Education Web site: www.edu.gov.on.ca

TYPES OF COURSES

NEW CREDIT COURSES: Open to all high school students and adults with the appropriate pre-requisites, students may take a new credit, or re-take a course previously attempted to upgrade a mark. Students may register for a maximum of two new credit courses (one eClass and one in-class course or two eClass courses).

REMEDIAL COURSES: These 60 hours courses are open to all high school students who completed the course in the previous two years and earned a final mark below 50%. Students who have successfully completed the credit with a mark of 50% or higher are not eligible for remedial credit courses. Students may register for a maximum of two remedial credit courses (one a.m. and one p.m.).

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

All students can register for our summer school courses starting on **Friday, May 4. Cancelled courses will be posted by Thurs., June 28.**

Please Note:

- Students may register for a maximum of two remedial courses, or two new credit courses (one eClass course and one in-class course)
- **We will accept students up to Friday, July 6th if space is available.**

TCDSB STUDENTS

1. Visit your guidance department for a blank registration form. Submit a completed registration form to your day school guidance counsellor. Mary Ward students: Please check with your guidance counsellor for course completion and available credit courses.

2. After submitting a completed registration form, obtain a Continuing Ed. timetable print-out from your guidance counsellor. This is your confirmation receipt that you have been registered successfully.

FUTURE GRADE 9 STUDENTS

1. Grade 8 students registering for a grade 9 credit course must obtain a registration form from their future grade 9 TCDSB secondary school.
2. Students are to submit their completed form to their future grade 9 TCDSB secondary school.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance and punctuality are mandatory. Students who do not attend the first day of class **may** forfeit their place and be placed on the waiting list. FINAL EVALUATION REVIEW & REPORT CARD PICKUP DAY - (STUDENTS MUST PICK UP THEIR REPORT CARD IN PERSON)

PLEASE NOTE: The final opportunity to review and discuss summer school results with your teacher is on **Friday, July 27, 2018 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. NO MARKS will be re-evaluated after this date.**

Report cards **MUST** be picked up at the summer school site on **Friday, July 27, 2018 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.**

NON-TCDSB students **MUST** submit a copy of their report card to their day school in order to have the credit added to their transcript.

Beginning August 13, students may request an additional copy of their report card by calling the Continuing Education Department at 416-222-8282 ext. 2135. **A \$10.00 fee will apply.** Report cards must be picked up at the Continuing Education Department, CEC.

EVALUATION

All students will be required to complete a final assessment.

Students that are unable to fulfill this condition will be considered not to have completed the course.

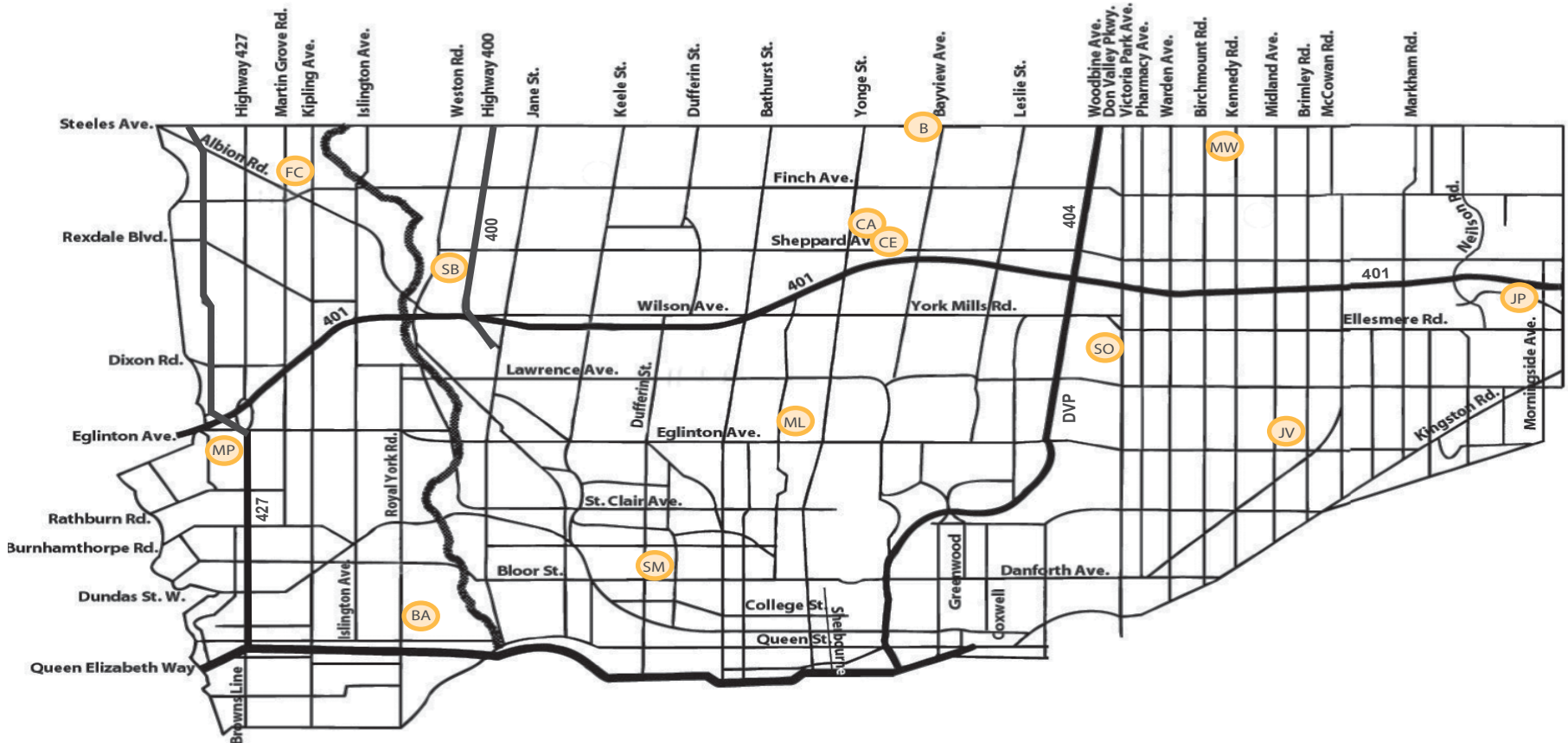

The TCDSB Continuing Education eClass program is dedicated to providing students with a learning experience that meets their academic and real world needs. There will be two sessions offered this summer. In order to minimize login issues please remember the following:

- **TCDSB students** need to remember their username and password (reset it before you leave school if you don't remember your password)
- **Non-TCDSB students** will use their OEN as a username, and will receive a password once registration is completed. An Ontario Education Number can be found on a report card/credit counselling summary and is nine digits in length.

Drop-in and YouTube Live support sessions will take place during the weeks of: **July 4-6, 9-12, 16-19, 23-26.**
