REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

All students can register for night and Saturday school courses starting on **Friday, September 1st until Friday, October 6th, 2017.** Based on enrolment, courses will be cancelled or redirected on **September 25th.** Students may register for a maximum of three courses. They can consist of eClass, Saturday or evening courses. Note: We will accept students up to **Friday, October 6th** if space is available. Proof of registration and photo ID will be requested on the first session of classes.
Note*: There will be NO ON-SITE REGISTRATION.

REGISTRATION: TCDSB STUDENTS

TO REGISTER:

1. Visit your guidance department for a blank registration form or print one from our website. Submit a completed registration form to your day school guidance counsellor.
2. Obtain a Continuing Ed. timetable print-out and a copy of your registration form from your guidance counsellor which indicates that you have been registered. This is your confirmation receipt that you have been registered successfully.
3. Please bring your completed registration form and your Continuing Ed. timetable print-out on the first day of classes. eClass students do not have to submit their registration documents to Continuing Ed. (Please read the section "Additional Information: eClass Online courses" for more information.)

This site works best in Internet Explorer with compatibility mode enabled. Full time NON-TCDSB students can only register for night and Saturday school courses. ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance and punctuality are mandatory. Students who do not attend the first day of class may forfeit their place and moved to the waiting list. Parents must contact the school during operating hours to report an absence or to inquire about their child's attendance. **eClass students who are unable to login must email eregister@tcdsb.org**

CLOSING OF CLASSES

The TCDSB reserves the right to cancel or relocate a class. A preliminary list of cancelled courses will be available on Friday, September 22, 2017. It is the student's responsibility to check our website for a list of all cancelled and relocated classes.

EVALUATION

All students will be required to write a final exam. Students who are unable to fulfill this condition will be considered to have not completed the course.

TEXTBOOK DEPOSIT

A textbook deposit of \$80 cash is required for each course. Monies will be refunded at the end of the course, provided borrowed materials are returned in good condition. Students taking Grade 12 courses are responsible for purchasing their own textbooks.

TYPES OF COURSES OFFERED

NEW CREDIT COURSES: Open to all high school students and adults with the appropriate pre-requisites. Students may take a new credit, or re-take a course previously taken to upgrade a mark. Please see the Night School eClass section for more information on online learning courses.

eCLASS: TCDSB STUDENTS

TCDSB students are to register for eClass courses by visiting their home school Guidance Office / Counsellor. Upon registering for Cont. Education eClass through their guidance department, students will receive a timetable print-out and login information from their Guidance counsellor. Attend a drop in support session or email eregister@tcdsb.org should you experience difficulties with the program or if you need further assistance.

ADULT LEARNERS, PART-TIME, PRIVATE STUDENTS

Adult learners, part-time or private school students are eligible to apply for eClass courses. Students with a full time schedule at a publicly funded school are not eligible to register this term. Adults and Part Time students registering for courses will be sent an acceptance email if placements in the requested courses are available. **To register, please refer to the NON-TCDSB registration section. Select "eClass" from the location drop down menu.**

eCLASS: DROP-IN SUPPORT SESSION

Students will have an opportunity to obtain support in using the online learning management system (brightspace by D2L). **Students are welcome to drop in for support between 4:30 PM to 7:30 PM on the following days: Tuesday September 26th to Thursday September 28th and from Tuesday October 3rd to Thursday October 5th.** Sessions will be held at the Catholic Education Centre (80 Sheppard Ave East). Students can drop in anytime during 4:30 PM to 7:30 PM to resolve login issues and/or to obtain general assistance. COURSE FEES - INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International VISA students must register in person at the Catholic Education Center, 80 Sheppard Avenue East. Please call 416-222-8282 ext. 2135 for an appointment and additional information. There are no course fees for Ontario students.

DISTRIBUTION OF REPORT CARDS

Students **MUST PICK-UP** their report cards during the last session of classes for Night and Saturday courses. Report cards will not be mailed home. Students enrolled in an eClass Online Learning course will be provided the date, time and location of when report cards will be ready for pick-up on the NEWS section on their classroom website.

NON-TCDSB Students: Students MUST bring their report card to their home school or transcript office. Contact your school board or guidance department regarding this procedure. The homeschool or transcript office will add the course to the transcript or upload to OUAC. A copy of the report card may be obtained by calling the Continuing Education Department. A \$10.00 fee will apply.

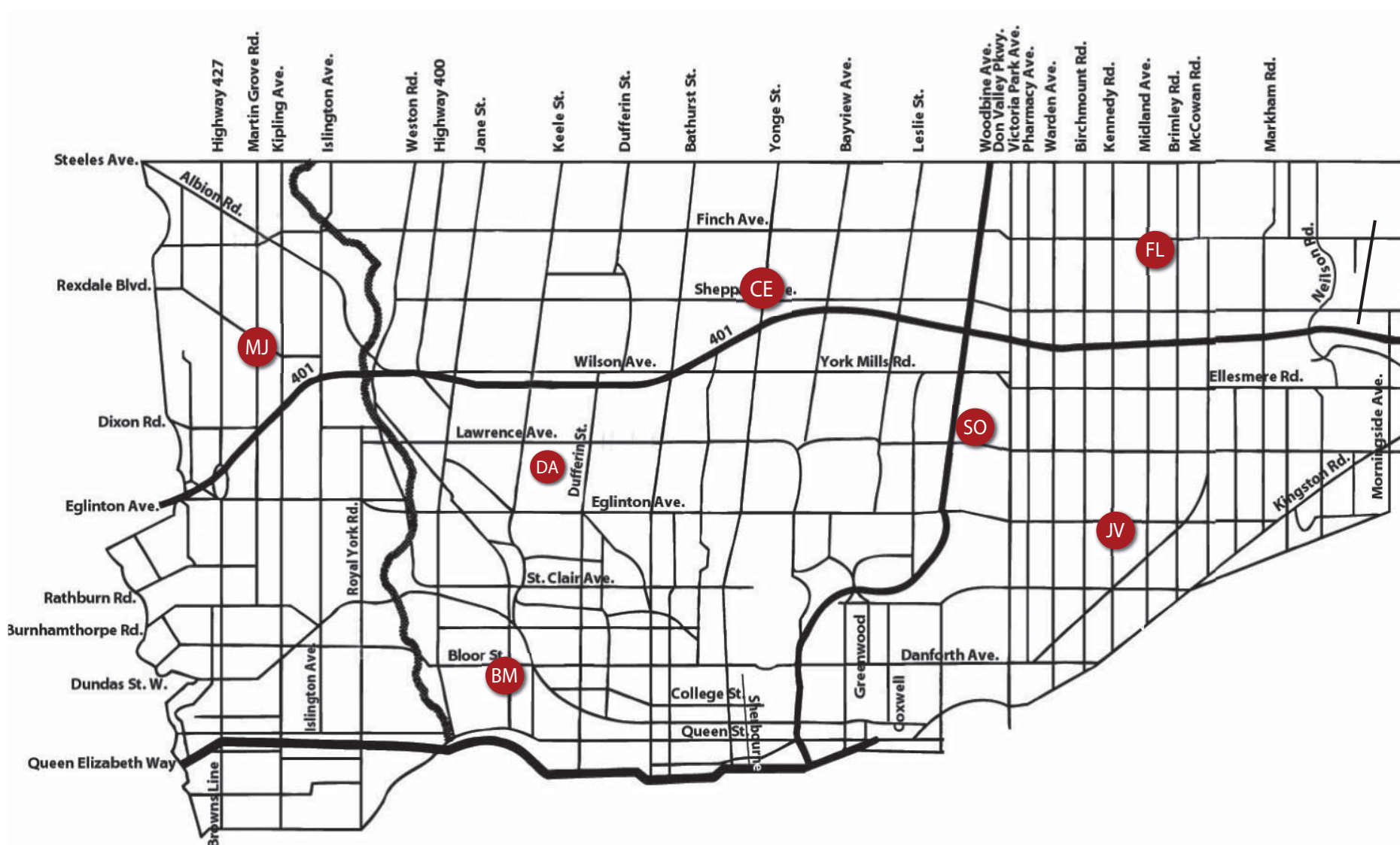
