TYPES OF COURSES

NEW CREDIT COURSES: Open to all high school students and adults with the appropriate pre-requisites. Students may take a new credit, or re-take a course previously taken to upgrade a mark. Students may register for a maximum of two new credit courses (one eClass and one in-class course or two eClass courses).

REMEDIAL COURSES: These 60 hours courses are open to all high school students who completed the course in the previous two years and earned a final mark below 50%. Students who have successfully completed the credit with a mark of 50% or higher are not eligible for remedial credit courses. Students may register for a maximum of two remedial credit courses (one a.m. and one p.m.).

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

All students can register for our summer school courses starting on **Friday, May 5. Cancelled courses will be posted by Thurs., June 29.**

Please Note:

- Students may register for a maximum of two remedial courses, or two new credit courses (one eClass course and one in-class course)
- **We will accept students up to Thurs., July 6th if space is available.**

TCDSB STUDENTS

1. Visit your guidance department for a blank registration form or print one from our website. Submit a completed registration form to your day school guidance counsellor. Mary Ward students: Please check with your guidance counsellor for course completion and available credit courses.

2. Obtain a Continuing Ed. timetable print-out and a copy of your registration form from your guidance counsellor which indicates that you have been registered. This is your confirmation receipt that you have been registered successfully.

3. Please bring your completed registration form and your Continuing Ed. timetable print-out on the first day of classes. eClass students do not have to submit their registration documents to Continuing Ed. (Please read the section for eClass courses on Page 4)

FUTURE GRADE 9 STUDENTS

1. Grade 8 students registering for a grade 9 credit course must obtain a registration form from their home school, any TCDSB secondary school or from our summer school website.

2. Students must complete the registration form and visit the guidance department at their future TCDSB secondary school and submit their summer school registration form. The guidance department will approve and enter the registration form directly into the system. Students will be given a timetable by the guidance department and should bring it in on the first day of summer school.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

ATTENDANCE

Regular attendance and punctuality are mandatory. Students who do not attend the first day of class **may** forfeit their place and be placed on the waiting list. Parents must contact the summer school location during school hours to report an absence or to inquire about their child's attendance. **eClass students who are unable to login must email eregister@tcdsb.org or attend one of the help session. FINAL EVALUATION REVIEW & REPORT CARD PICKUP DAY - (STUDENTS MUST PICK UP THEIR REPORT CARD IN PERSON)

Report cards **MUST** be picked up at the summer school site on **Friday, July 28, 2017 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.**

NON-TCDSB students **MUST** submit a copy of their report card to their Guidance Department of their day school in order to have the credit entered on their transcript.

PLEASE NOTE: The final opportunity to review and discuss summer school results with your teacher is on **Friday, July 28, 2017 from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. NO MARKS will be re-evaluated after this date.**

Beginning August 14, students may request an additional copy of their report card by calling the Continuing Education Department at 416-222-8282 ext. 2135. A \$10.00 fee will apply. Report cards must be picked up at the Continuing Education Department, CEC.

EVALUATION

All students will be required to write a final exam. Students that are unable to fulfill this condition will be considered not to have completed the course.

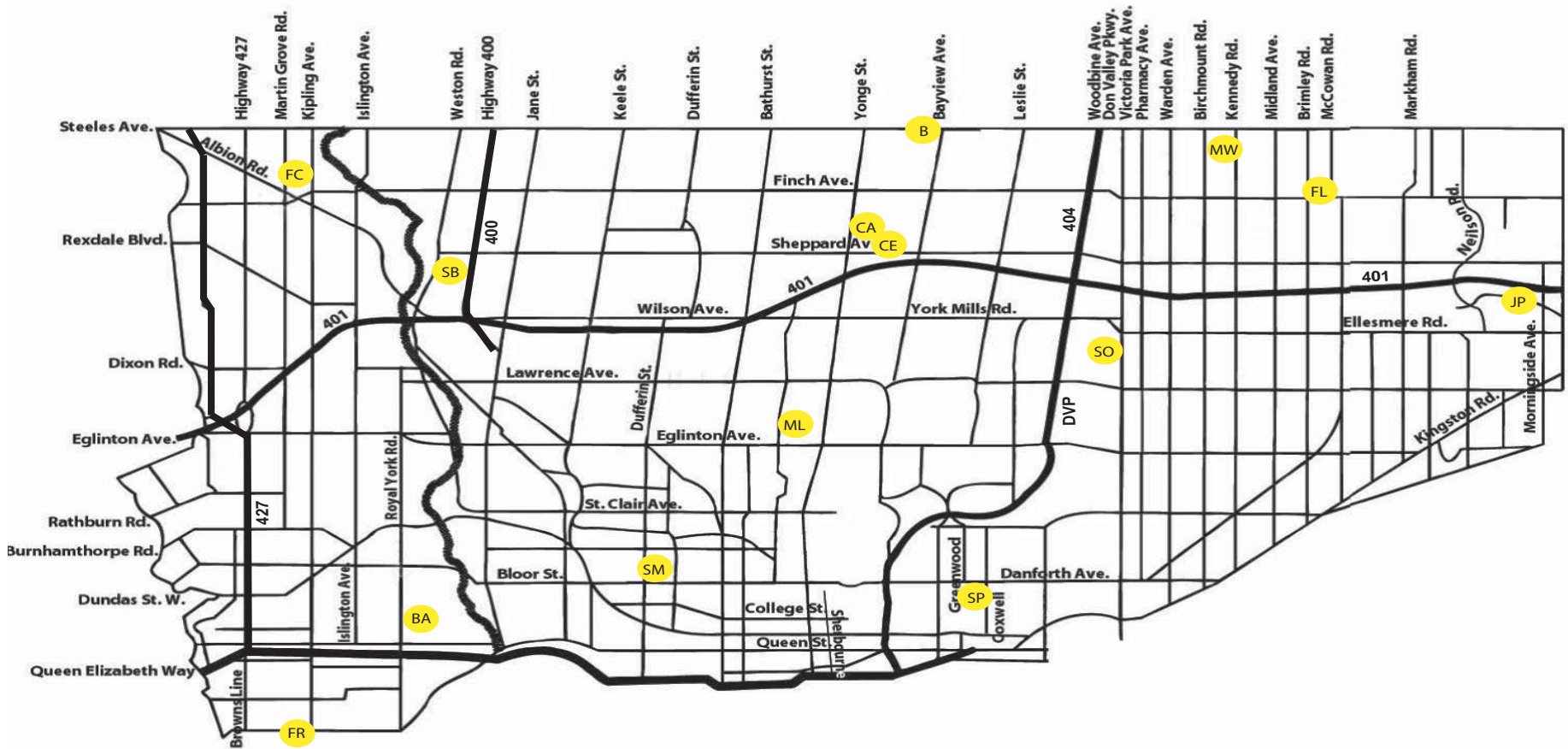
