We look forward to the excitement that a new school year always brings and to your continued partnership and support of Catholic Education as we welcome in the 2021-2022 school year.

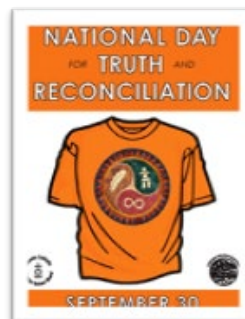

**Orange Shirt Day** also known as the **National Day for Truth and Reconciliation**, It was created as an observance in 2013, and is designed to educate people and promote awareness in Canada about the residential school system and the impact it has had on Indigenous communities for over a century. The colour of the shirt is connected to the experience of Phyllis Webstad who was sent to Cariboo Residential School near Williams Lake, BC, in 1973. The shirt has since gone on to become a symbol of a national movement that recognizes the suffering of Indigenous children at residential schools across the country and to show a renewed commitment to ensure that every child matters. Our St Anne students and staff are encouraged to participate in activities in their classes during September and leading up to **September 30, 2021**, in addition to wearing Orange, to recognize the resiliency and bravery of Residential School Survivors

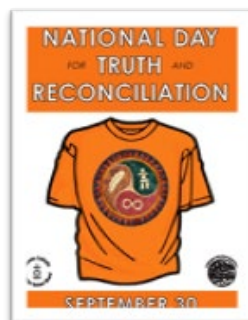
