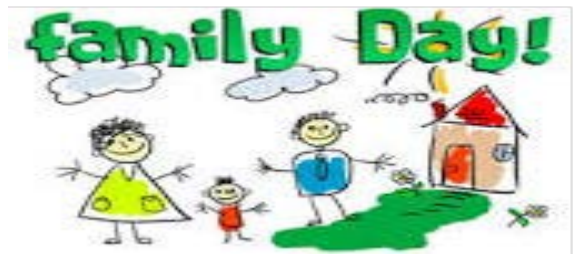

## Safety and Supervision

- Please continue to use our Safe Arrival Program for student absences/lates by calling **416-393-5408** before 8:30 a.m. Clearly leave your child's name and reason for his/her absence. Please do not drop off your children prior to 8:45 a.m. as there is no supervision available.
- All visitors to the school, including parents and guardians, must report to the office. Please do not escort your child to his or her classroom.
- If you wish to talk to a teacher, please telephone for an appointment.
- If your child has an appointment, please send a note to your child's teacher if early pick-up of your child is necessary so the teacher will have them prepared.
- ALL children ***MUST*** be signed out by parents when an early pick up arises.

## Parking/ Drop off and Pick up

Your cooperation is vital in ensuring the safety of our children. Please follow these routines;

- Park your car at the large church parking lot and walk your children across the street. **DO NOT** park or block the church rectory driveway in front of the school.
- **DO NOT** stop or park on the road, it is a no parking zone.
- **DO NOT** stop or park in the bus loading zone.
- Drive around the block to exit,
- **DO NOT** make a three point turn.
- **DO NOT** let your children out of the automobile on the road side, other vehicles cannot see you.
- The school parking lot will be closed during dismissal hours to help with student safety.
