### **Summer Safety Tips**

Apply sunscreen with SPF 30 or more to protect your child from UV rays that can cause sunburns. Apply it 15 – 30 minutes before sun exposure.

Drink plenty of water when spending time outside to avoid dehydration and keep yourself and your children refueled.

Always wear sunglasses when in the sun to protect your eyes from UV rays.

Limit sun exposure, especially between the hours of 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. when UV rays are strongest (especially in the summer).

Take time to ensure the outdoor play areas around your home are safe in order to protect your child from injuries in their own backyard.

Use insect and tick repellent when hiking, camping, or just playing outdoors, especially in wooded areas.

Enrol your child in swimming classes or closely supervise them when in the pool, at the beach, or at the lake to ensure they stay safe around the water.

Wear a bike helmet every time you ride to protect your head, face, and brain in case you fall.

Enjoy outdoor activities together as a family! Nothing protects your child better than your presence!

St. Rene Goupil's school uniform consists of navy bottoms and white or navy *collared* shirts.

White or navy blue tops must have sleeves and collars and indoor sweaters must be navy or white with no large logos.

Please note that jeggings, leggings, skinny jeans, and denim are not permitted as school dress code. Please keep this in mind when shopping for navy bottoms as they are not dress code and should not be worn to school. Navy uniform pants, or sweatpants without large logos are acceptable navy bottoms.

## St. Rene Goupil Multi-Language School

The Toronto Catholic District School Board is announcing that registration is now open for its first multi-language elementary school. Students eligible to start school in Full-Day Kindergarten (FDK) or Grade 1 for September 2017 may register using the TCDSB's Student Online Academic Registration (SOAR) application tool. This unique school program is being located at St. René Goupil Catholic School in Scarborough, and is modelled on the familiar French Immersion program featuring instruction in French. Specific subjects and other parts of the curriculum will also be taught in Spanish, Mandarin and English. St. René Goupil Catholic School is located at 44 Port Royal Trail in north Scarborough. Although school bus transportation could not be provided to students from outside the area, a child care facility is available on site. The multi-language school is open to families living anywhere in the City of Toronto who meet the elementary school admission requirements for the TCDSB.
