

Information Regarding September 2017 and The Holy Trinity C.S.

Question: Is there a delay in the opening of the new building, The Holy Trinity C.S.?

Answer: *Yes, due to weather conditions and their impact on completion of the structure, despite best efforts, the new building will not be ready for September 2017. It is expected that the school could be completed late in the Fall. Every effort is being made to get students into the new school as soon as possible.*

Question: How will this impact the school community?

Answer: *Christ the King and St. Teresa C.S. will be closing at the end of June 2017, but the physical buildings will remain open until we are ready to move into our new school. To ease the transition into The Holy Trinity C.S, we will use two campuses. Students in Kindergarten through grade 4 will attend classes at the St. Teresa site and the Grades 5-8 will attend classes at to school at the Christ the King site.*

Question: I have one child or more, who currently have transportation to CTK. They will continue at CTK campus, will transportation be provided?

Answer: *Yes, this will not change.*

Question: I have one child or more, who currently does not have transportation to CTK. They will continue at CTK campus, will transportation be provided?

Answer: *No. These are students who are within the 1.5km walking distance.*

Question: I have one child or more, who currently have transportation to CTK, however they will now be attending the St. Teresa campus. Will transportation be provided?

Answer: *Yes transportation will be provided. Bus route information will be available at the end of June. Please note there is no door to door service for any student in the TCDSB, unless they have special needs.*

Question: I have two children, who will attend **two different campuses** (this is for children who currently have and don't have transportation). Will transportation be provided?

Answer: *Yes. Here is an example; Teah (Grade 7) and Michael (Grade 4) are siblings. Teah will attend CTK campus and Michael will attend St. Teresa campus. Both children will get picked up together at the same bus stop in the morning. Teah will be dropped off at CTK campus and the bus will continue on to St. Teresa campus to drop off Michael. At dismissal, Michael will get on his bus and the same bus will go and pick up Teah, followed by drop off at their bus stop.*

Question: Is there a Before and After School Program?

Answer: *Yes, the YMCA will be our provider for The Holy Trinity. It will continue to operate out of St. Teresa for our JK to Grade 4 students. If a parent requests that their child in Grade 5 and up receives after school care, then they will be dropped off by the school bus at St. Teresa after school. It is recommended that if you are interested in the YMCA that you contact Katrina at Katrina.Hurst@YMCA.GTA.ORG, as soon as possible. It is imperative that you register early to increase your probability of getting into the program. The program will run from 7a.m.-8:30a.m. and 3:00-6p.m.*

Question: What will happen to the teaching staff?

Answer: *The staff of CTK and St. Teresa have been allocated to The Holy Trinity C.S. and they too, will move with their new grade which will help students adjust to their new building as there will be many familiar faces to greet and support them.*

Question: What will the class make-up be?

Answer: *Every effort is being made to ensure that ALL classes have a balance of students from St Teresa and Christ the King, as well as having a balance of male/female. We have been conscientiously trying to build relationships between both schools, and we hope that our efforts will be evident once the students are together.*
