November is the month of Peace

The Angel, appearing to the shepherds near Bethlehem after Jesus's birth, said to them, "Glory to God in the highest, and peace to his people on Earth"; Jesus, appearing before his disciples after the Resurrection, greeted his friends by saying, "Peace be with you." Peace – it is a God-given gift: not just a feeling of relaxation and comfort, but the final settling of all this world's problems, the complete anti-dote to everything that upsets us, the greatest blanket of security and calm. Peace is God giving a bit of Himself and of Heaven to us. God, we remember, appeared not in the earthquake, not in the storm, not in the fire, but in the silence afterwards. November is the month of Peace.

Not surprisingly, November is also the month we remember. It is the time of year to remember all the saints and all the souls who have passed on before us, and it is the time of year to remember the soldiers who died fighting for our freedom. Remembrance Day is our gift to those soldiers, an opportunity to bring the peace – that God gives to us – to them, to take them away from the violence, the upset, the destruction, and cover them with peace.

November is also an opportunity to listen to what the Angel said to the shepherds, and to what Jesus said to his disciples, and know that they were talking to us as well, that we are invited to bring that peace – that gift of God – into our own hearts. Let's not search for God in the earthquake or the storm or the fire, but in the silence.
