Classroom News

Curriculum:

In Religion, we discussed the virtue of courage, and the Feast of the Epiphany. The students listened to a few stories that explained the story of the Epiphany and wrote about what they learned.

In Language, we learned the sounds Oo, Uu, Ll, and Ff. We have been encouraging our JK students to write all sounds they hear in their independent writing. Students wrote about the Feast of the Epiphany and what they enjoy doing in the winter. Other journals included facts about polar animals (our new topic in Science).

In Math, we graphed the weather in January, we focused our counting from 1-100 and started learning about position and location using words like above, below, beside, etc..

In Art, the Kinders enjoyed making the three wise men out of craft sticks.
