



Congregated AP Program at Father Henry Carr Specialty Program Application Form



Information and Guidelines

The Congregated Advanced Placement (AP) Program at Father Henry Carr provides an enriched classroom setting for highly-motivated students in the areas of English, Math, Science, French, Art, French, and Geography. The program begins in Grade 9 with Pre-AP classes in which students study both the Ontario and the AP curriculum and leads to AP classes in Grades 11 and 12 that prepare students to write AP exams for advanced placement or credit in university. The Congregated AP Program is also an excellent enrichment opportunity for students who are identified Gifted. All strong academic students are encouraged to apply.

The flexibility of the AP Program allows students to select the number of AP classes that suit their learning needs. While some students might choose as few as one AP class, others may select the full complement of courses offered in order to work towards the AP International Diploma which is recognized world-wide.

Father Henry Carr will accept a limited number of students into the Congregated AP Program in Grade 9. Places of admission into the program will be granted based on previous report cards, CAT 3 scores, principal/teacher's confidential reports, as well as the student's desire to commit to the level of study required by the enriched classroom setting.

Application Fees

There is a \$10.00 non-refundable application fee payable to Father Henry Carr required with this application.

Future Costs

In the Grade 11 or 12 year, in which students write the AP exam, there is a \$100.00 fee charged by the College Board for each AP exam written. Students can speak to the AP Coordinator to make alternate financial arrangements.

Deadline for Application

This application must be forwarded to Father Henry Carr no later than **December 12, 2008**. After this date, applications will be accepted to the Congregated AP Program if space permits. Please note that in addition to this application, students must also apply to the school through the regular TCDSB admission process.

Notification of Acceptance

Father Henry Carr will contact all candidates by mail in the last week of February, 2009, as to whether or not they have been offered admission to the Congregated AP Program.
