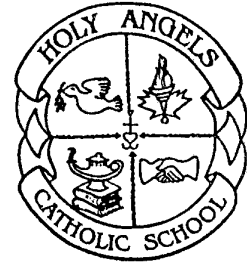

FOCUS GROUPS - Groups within the school who require additional support
 We will be focusing on moving our male students who are 2.5-2.9 into level 3. Teachers will monitor 2 students per semester using an Assessment Tool sent through our Google Drive.

URGENT CRITICAL LEARNING NEED - Schools have many learning needs. This is the most urgent and critical learning need that will be addressed this year.
 Solving application, thinking and reasoning problems where students can explain, describe and communicate their understanding.

SMART GOAL - School goal for student learning that school will focus on achieving throughout the year.
 Of the 456 students in grades 1-8, we will move 10% (42 marker students) from a level 2.5 - 2.9 to level 3 or above range, as measured by the 2019-2020 EQAO results and class assessments.

REQUIRED PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

STAFF PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CRITICAL NEED - In order to address the student urgent critical need of the school and to work toward the school's SMART goal, the following professional development is required.
 Local P.D. (i.e. lunch and learns, board code days) focusing on problem solving strategies and communication
 School wide bi-weekly/monthly mental math and problem of the week
 Review and create student assessments according to the four categories of assessment (KATC)
 Strategic use of math resource teacher
 Co-teaching among grade partner and throughout divisions
 Math learning walk to demonstrate the continuum of learning expectations (Catholic Education Week)
 Sharing of best practices and resources among colleagues

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN - Professional learning topics that will be undertaken by staff throughout the year.

- With support from Luca Vetta, TCDSB Math Resource Teacher, PD will be planned to utilize the allotted code days with the Junior Division, focusing on our Area of Critical Need
