SCHOOL HOURS AND SUPERVISION

Please remember that **the school day ends at 3:30 pm and the office is closed at 4:00 pm**. All students must be picked up by 4:00 pm, as supervision is not provided after this time. Students who are not picked up by 4:00 pm will be placed in our after care program, Dovercourt Boys and Girls Club, and a fee will be charged.

If you require after care, please contact the Dovercourt Boys and Girls Club to register for the program, 416.536.4102. The after care program runs from 3:30 to 5:30 each day and is \$5 daily for students aged 6 to 12, and \$10 for kindergarten students.

JUMP ROPE FOR HEART

Holy Rosary will again be participating in the Heart and Stroke Foundation Jump Rope for Heart this year. Our Jump event day is **April 3**. We have set a fundraising goal of \$4000 for this year. Students and staff had a great day of jumping and staying active while raising over \$3000 for the Heart and Stroke foundation last year, and we look forward to your generous support again this spring!

SOCKS 4 SOULS

Ms Caputo's class has kicked off the Socks 4 Souls campaign, running to April 5. **We aim to collect 500 pairs of socks which will be donated to various shelters around Toronto.** Foot problems like infections and frostbite make up 20% of all medical complaints of homeless people. Clean socks can help change this reality. Let's share the love, hope, charity and caring of the Holy Rosary community with those in need.

LICE CHECKS

Head lice can affect anyone. Lice can live up to 30 days on a person's head and is spread through close head-to-head contact. **Parents are encouraged to be vigilant and check their children's heads on a regular basis for lice and nits (lice eggs).** Resources are available online through Toronto Public Health. Discourage head-to-head contact, sharing of hats, brushes and combs. If you discover lice or nits on your child, please advise the main office and your child's teacher so that a class check can be arranged.

SCHOOL ACCESS: BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL HOURS

Please note that **access to the school before and after regular school hours, and without permission from the main office, is not permitted.** Please do not return to your child's class or hallway after dismissal. This includes during and after the Dovercourt Boys and Girls Club program hours. Participation in the Dovercourt programs before and after school limits facility access to those specific areas of the school ONLY. If something is lost or forgotten in the classroom, please speak with the office or your child's teacher during regular school hours, 8:45 am to 4:00 pm.
