Religion and Family Life

In Religion students will understand that Lent is the time for the friends of Jesus to prepare for Easter. In Family Life they will continue to recognize and value the importance of compromises with friends and of trying to be friendly toward everyone in the group.

Language

In Reading, students continue to use the A.P.E. model when responding to comprehension questions. They provide evidence in the text to support their responses. They make connections to the text and explain how these connections enrich their comprehension. They also make inferences about texts using stated and implied ideas from the texts as evidence.

In Writing, students continue to write short texts using a variety of describing words and sentence structures. Students are reviewing Level 4 exemplars and then making revisions to improve the content and interest of their written work.

In Word Study, students continue to learn strategies to spell words through weekly spelling lessons.

Math

Students will add and subtract 3-digit numbers, add and subtract money and calculate change.

Social Studies

The Grade 2s continue to describe traditions and celebrations of their own communities and other communities in Canada. The Grade 3s continue to recognize how the natural features of the environment influence land use and how human activities affect the environment.

Science

The Grade 3 students will explore forces causing movement with Scientist Zane when she visits our classroom on Feb. 18.
