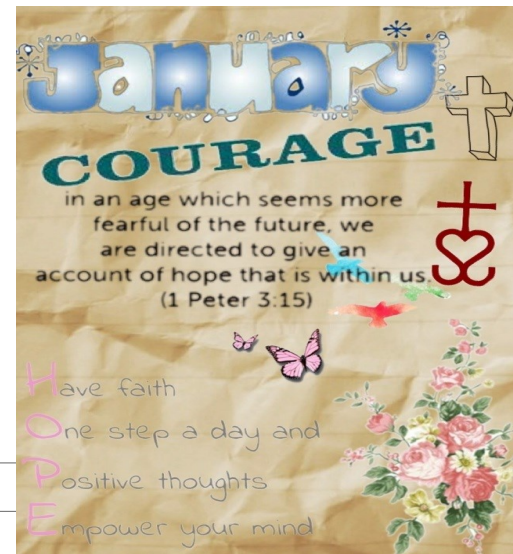
Thank you for all your support and encouragement during our Christmas Concert. The students worked really hard to display both their singing and dancing talents.
