Please continue to have your child dressed appropriately for outdoor play. Just a reminder, to label your child's winter clothing. Please provide your child with indoor shoes that they are able to fasten and unfasten themselves.

The virtue of the month for March is Forgiveness. Our themes this month will be the following: Lenten Promises, St. Patrick's Day, The Local Community, and Energy in our Lives.

In Language Arts, the S.K.'s are writing pattern sentences using thematic related words and other sight word vocabulary. In March, we will be working on the letters ie, ee, and or. The Grade one's will practise expanding their writing skills, and practise adding capital letters and periods to familiar rhymes.

In the Grade one Math program, we will be learning about Measuring Capacity and Mass, and Exploring Time and Money. The following topics will be our next focus:

- Measuring Capacity by Pouring, and Measuring Capacity with Nonstandard Units
- Comparing Mass
- Measuring Mass with Nonstandard Units
- Measuring Halves
- Sequencing Events and Measuring Time
- Using the Analog Clock
- Telling and Writing Time to the Hour, Telling and Writing Time to the Half-Hour
- Exploring Coins, and Counting Coin Combinations
- Using Coins to Make Purchases

Just a reminder that Library is on Wednesday, and gym is on Mondays and Wednesdays. Please make sure your child has proper running shoes for gym.
