



Religion and Family Life

In Religion students continue to learn about Pentecost and the effects of the coming of the Holy Spirit upon Jesus’ followers. In Family Life they continue to learn that everyone makes decisions and that they have to be made carefully and that other people can help us make good decisions.

Language

In Reading, students continue to use the A.P.E. model when responding to comprehension questions. They provide evidence in the text to support their responses. They make connections to the text and explain how these connections enrich their comprehension. They also make inferences about texts using stated and implied ideas from the texts as evidence.

In Writing, students continue to write short texts using a variety of describing words and sentence structures. Students are reviewing Level 4 exemplars and then making revisions to improve the content and interest of their written work.

In Word Study, students continue to learn strategies to spell words through weekly spelling lessons.

Math

Students are learning about 3-D Geometry. They are describing and naming prisms and pyramids by the shape of their base.

Science

Grade 3 students continue to learn about forces causing movement. Grade 2 students continue to learn about movement and ways in which simple machines help to move objects.
