Religion and Family Life

In Religion the theme is "Friendship". Through story, discussion and mime, the students will share what they enjoy doing with their friends, and reflect on our understanding of friendship. In Family Life the theme is, "Created and Loved by God". Each of us is created in the image of God and we share a common human nature. We are all able to love, to laugh, to think, to feel a great variety of emotions, to make choices, and to hope. Each of us also experiences weakness, and the need for God's grace.

Language:

Reading: The students are learning about the features of fiction and non-fiction books. Through class read a louds we are identifying the elements of fiction books: character, setting, problem, solution and main idea or lesson learned.

Word Study: The students will review letter sounds and combinations. The grade 1's will be using weekly word families to practice blending sounds (an, ap, and an family of words) and the grade 2's will learn strategies of spelling words through their weekly spelling lessons. They will begin with the short vowel sounds and move towards the long vowel sound (vowel sound and vowel name).

Writing: The grade1 students are working on sentence structure. In their writing we are looking for simple but complete sentences, that there is a period at the end of the sentence and that there are spaces between words. The grade 2 students are being introduced to the paragraph. The students are learning how to structure a paragraph (title, topic sentence, supporting sentences and a closing sentence). Teacher modeling is used for this and students help generate a class paragraph based on an event that has taken place at school or an item that a student will bring in for show and tell.

Math: In Mathematics we have begun "Numbers to 50". Through varied experiences with

counting, comparing, measuring and using money, students will make connections with real-life number contexts in order to help make sense of our number system. Goals: use ordinal numbers to the 31st, count items in groups of 2, 5, and 10, explore counting patterns, model 2-digit numbers using a variety of materials and compare numbers. Words to know: digit, estimate, group, greater than, less than and skip count.

Science: The grade 2 students are studying “Animals”. Throughout the unit the children will identify and describe the major physical characteristics of mammals, reptiles, and amphibians, they will learn about animal life cycles, and describe ways in which animals respond and adapt to their environments. The grade 1 students are studying “Living Things”. In their studies they will learn about the senses. They will identify the 5 senses and the function of their sense organs. They will also identify living and non-living things, identify changes in the appearance of young and mature living things and identify some needs of living things.
