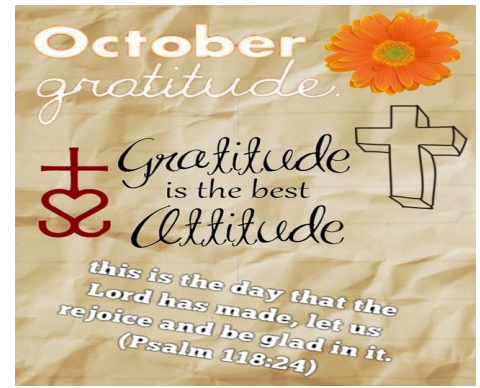


# The Grade 4/5 Classroom Update

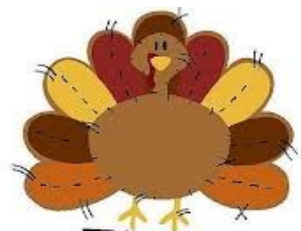
