

# How to Choose Courses for Grade 10 at Monsignor Percy Johnson

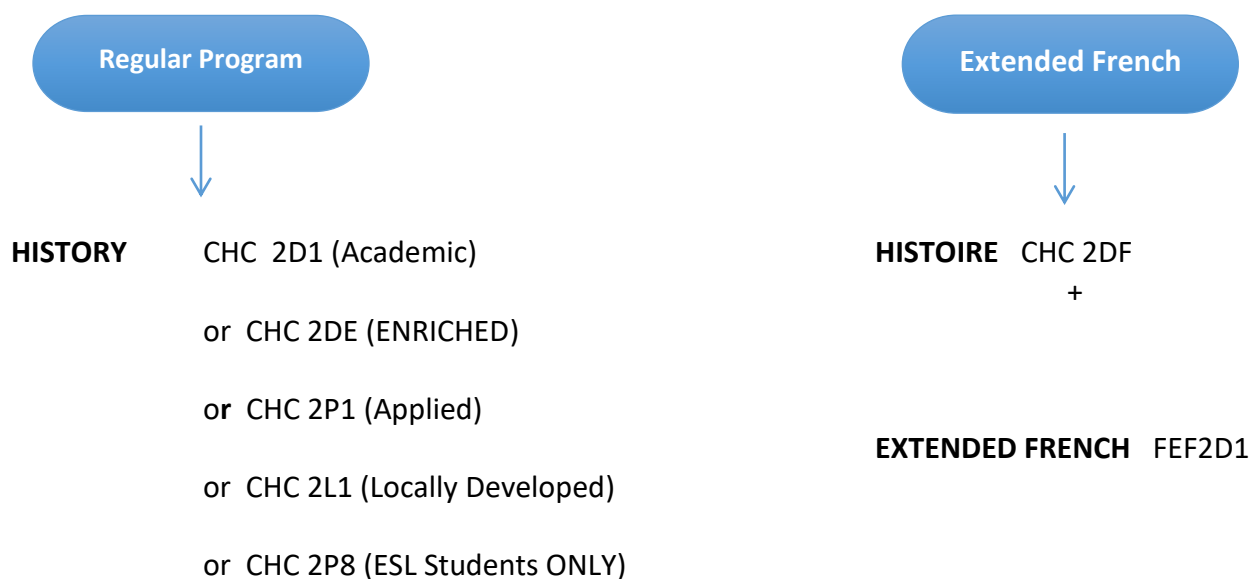
**ALL grade 10 students must choose 8 courses plus 2 alternates:**

## **1. EVERY STUDENT CHOOSES FROM THESE: (choose *one of each* course)**

<b>ENGLISH</b>	ENG 2D1 (Academic) or ENG 2DE (Enriched) or ENG 2P1 (Applied) or ENG 2L1 (Locally Developed) or ESL ( <i>for new immigrant to the country</i> )
<b>MATH</b>	MPM 2D1 (Academic) or MPM 2DE (Enriched) or MFM 2P1 (Applied) or MAT 2L1 (Locally Developed)
<b>SCIENCE</b>	SNC 2D1 (Academic) or SNC 2P1 (Applied) or SNC 2L1 (Locally Developed)
<b>RELIGION</b>	HRE 2O1 (Open – all students must take Religion)
<b>CAREER/CIVICS</b>	PCC 2O1 (Open – all students must take Career & Civics)

**NOTE:** The **Enriched courses** are only for those students that applied for the Enriched/AP Math and/or English program in Grade 9.

3. LASTLY, CHOOSE **Two ELECTIVES** from the list below: You must add **Two alternate courses** in the slots provided in case we cannot schedule your first choice.

**NOTE: Art Requirement:** In grade 9 if you did not take an Art course, you must take one in Grade 10 to fulfill the Gradation expectations

**NOTE: Physical Education Requirement:** In grade 9 if you did not take a Phys. Education class, you must take one in grade 10 to fulfill the Graduation expectation.

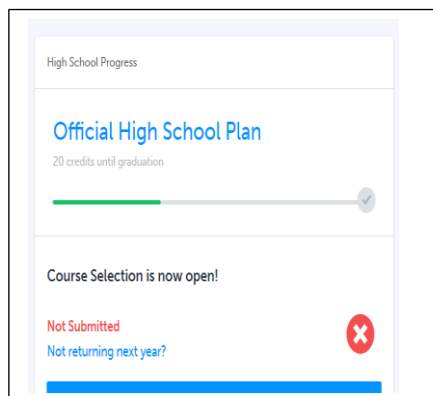

6. Fill out the sign up form and click **Create Account**

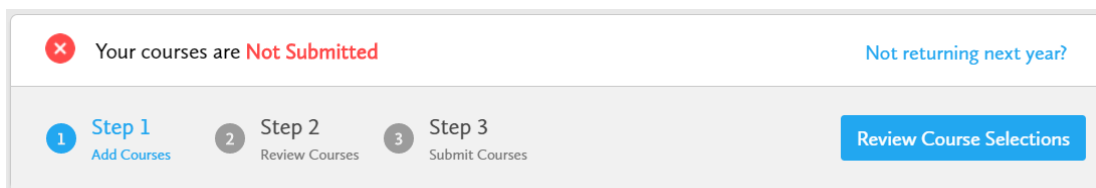
## 5. COMPLETE YOUR COURSE SELECTION A to F

From your **Dashboard**, click on the **Plan Courses** button that appears in the Course Selection box at the top left

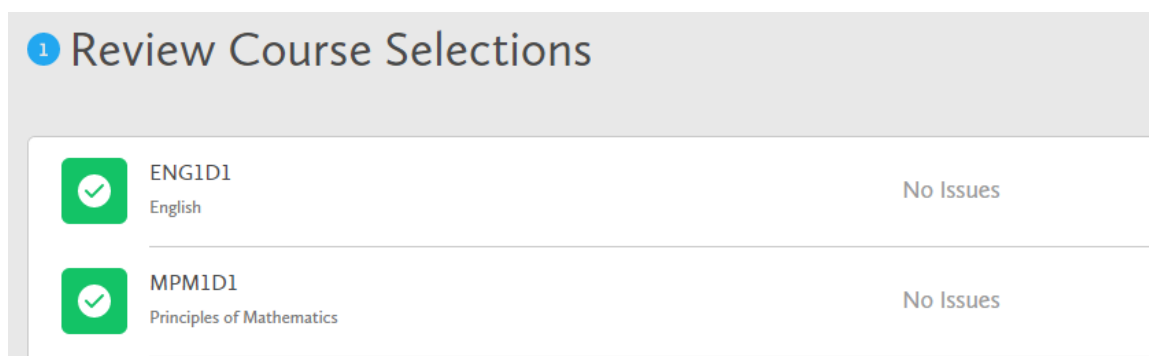


## A) ADD COURSES FOR NEXT YEAR

- In High School Planner, click + **[Course]**. Subjects you need to choose from are already listed in grey to remind you what you need to select– just choose the correct level you want, or you can pick a different course in that slot.
- In the **Course Selection and Details** screen, explore the available courses.
- Click **Add Course to Plan** when you find the course you want. Remember to add 8 courses and two alternates (we will consider your selected alternates if we cannot place you in your first choice if we cannot accommodate you in your first two chosen electives).

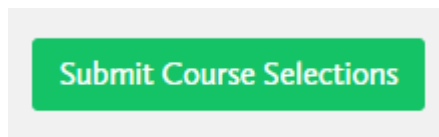


- B) **REVIEW COURSES** – When you are ready to submit your course selections, click the **Review Course Selections** button and give your course selection one final look over.



**CAUTION:** If the course appear **RED**, then please review. You do not have the prerequisite and will not be able to take it.

- c) **SUBMIT COURSES** – Once you have confirmed that the courses, which appear, are correct, click on **Submit Course Selections**.





**D) SUBMIT COURSES** – Once you have carefully reviewed the **Details** page to ensure that you are meeting the requirements for the courses you have selected and that the courses that appear are correct, click on **Submit Course Selections**. Please note that you will not be able to modify your course selections once submitted (unless your guidance counsellor re-allows submission)!

## **E) EMAIL PARENT APPROVAL**

- Click the blue **Send Approval Email** to email your parent/guardian to approve your course selections,
- **YOU MUST HAVE YOUR PARENTS’/GUARDIAN’S EMAIL ADDRESS. YOU CAN SEND IT TO BOTH PARENTS**
