1. Approval of Minutes – approved by Tiffany Sousa, seconded by Fruzsina Darabos
2. Approval of Agenda – approved Rita Marrari, second by Fruzsina Darabos
3. Treasurer’s Report – Tiffany Sousa
Nothing has changed from the previous meeting. Recap below of previous information:
 - End of School balance: \$10,915.55
 - Not included is the \$2,000.00 PIC (Parent Involvement Committee Grant) which would make our total \$12,915.55.
 - We allotted \$500.00 for the recess bags. Mr. D’Sousa has already spent \$265.55 leaving \$234.45 still to spend.
 - Closing September 2019 balance \$12,681.10. The opening balance does not include the expenditures to start the school year.
4. Updates and communication from Administration – Mr. Femia
 - Mr. Femia presented the Professional Learning Form to CSPC. There is a School Improvement Team (SIT) and it is 5 staff including Mr. Femia. The form is used to help the school improve in things such as numeracy and EQAO.

 - On Tuesday, November 5th, 2019 the Intermediates will be going on a trip to The Paramount Fine Foods.
