Dear Parents/Guardians, Principal and School staff of Our Lady of Perpetual Help school:

At its meeting held on January 21, 2016, the Board considered the report 'Elementary Boundary Review Ranking – All Wards,' and approved the initiation of a boundary review for **Our Lady of Perpetual Help**.

The Board is committed to ensuring that the effectiveness of fixed attendance boundaries is monitored on an ongoing basis, in an effort to better manage enrolment at oversubscribed schools.

When the current school boundary was approved in 2012, the Board also approved a review of the boundary in 2015 to ensure that it was working to help bring long-term sustainability to what is an oversubscribed school. That promised review is now taking place.

The boundary review will take place in accordance with the Toronto Catholic District School Board's Elementary School Attendance Boundary Review Policy (S.A. 03), which can be viewed on the Board's website at: <https://www.tcdsb.org/Board/Policies/Documents/SA03.pdf>.
