

## Committees – 2013/2014

**Communications** - Put into place a logical overall strategy for communication amongst parents and between parents and school.

**Events** - Create a masterlist of events at the school and enlist volunteers for each event. Act as a liaison with CSAC. Ensure learnings are documented, budget followed.

**Academic** - In collaboration with the teachers and principal, identify initiatives and existing resources to improve the academic achievement of the students and provide the resources required. Review test score (EQAO, other) and investigate what other schools are doing in academics.

**Technology/21 Century Learning** - Create an overall multiyear plan for the procurement of technology for the school which will maximize the academic benefit and complement board strategies.

**Extracurricular Activities** - In collaboration with the teachers and principal, identify initiatives to improve the student's general overall experience at St. Anselm's. May include:

- **Sports** - Evaluate the current sports and investigate the desire and feasibility of any new sports.
- **Arts** - Evaluate the current offerings and recommend any new programs..
- **Clubs** - Research which clubs would be of interest to the students, parents and teachers.
- **Other initiatives** - Such as W5H, science fairs, public speaking, etc.

**Parent Engagement/Presentations** - Coordinate educational seminars, speaker series etc...

**School Beautification** - Coordinate parent's contribution to maintenance of garden, school grounds and indoor spaces where appropriate.

**Catechism** – Investigate ways to support and promote knowledge and understanding of the Catholic faith and traditions within the school and the community.
