WELCOME AND PRAYER

Mr. Walo welcomed parents and called the meeting to order and led the opening prayer≥

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

ON A MOTION made by Mr. Corkery and SECONDED by Ed Abdou the Minutes from CSAC meeting held September 17, 2014 was approved.

BOUNDARY UPDATE – John Volek

John Volek discussed the boundary of St. Anselm's Catholic School. The boundary is considered "fixed" east of Bayview and a flex or optional attendance boundary dependant on space to the west of Bayview to Forman Ave.

Current enrolment for 2014/2015 is 370. The school cap is anywhere from 338-340.

Some confusion as to if there had been a boundary change as new parents to the school commented that before January 8th 2014 when they viewed the Board website it showed a fixed Boundary west of Bayview Ave. to Forman Ave. and then as of January 10th 2014 the fixed Boundary moved to east of Bayview Ave. Mrs. Bright stated that she spoke to Mr. Volek at a meeting and asked if there was going to be a change to the boundary at which time he told her no.

Angela Kennedy discussed requesting a boundary review and formally asked John Volek for one for November. John Volek could not commit to having it done by then.

SPACE ISSUE IN THE SCHOOL – Maia Puccetti

3 options:

1. Subdividing library
 - a. Drywall easy to put up and take down – about 2 weeks to complete. Goal to be ready by end of November
2. Portable
 - a. Would have to remove the senior play structure. Timeline: mid December
3. Church
 - a. not an option at this point. No Windows, no ventilation. Would need a PA and data drop. Don't own the building, exiting issues.
4. 3rd floor
 - a. cost prohibitive

Len Corkery motioned to subdivide the library – unanimous vote by the parent present.

Parents raised the issue of fire code versus the number of students and were told that it is all based on exiting capabilities and that the school was up to code.
