

# Appropriate Dress Code Policy Chart

<i>Clothing</i>	<i>Details</i>
<p>Plain white or navy tops include:</p> <p>Short and long-sleeved shirts with appropriate collar (golf shirts, dress shirts, blouses) or turtle necks</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tops with sleeves</li> <li>• With collars, no t-shirts</li> <li>• Any added details need to be consistent with colour of shirt (lace, logos, color etc)</li> </ul>
<p>Plain navy blue bottoms include:</p> <p>Walking shorts, skorts, skirts, kilt, tunic dress, capri/cargo pants, dress/casual pant</p> <hr style="border: 1px solid black;"/> <p>Athletic Wear (on appropriate days)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Athletic shorts</li> <li>▪ White or navy blue T-shirt</li> <li>▪ Track pants/yoga pants</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shorts (walking or athletic) are to be mid-thigh or longer</li> <li>• Skorts are skirts with shorts sewn inside</li> <li>• Cargo pants are 3/4 length pants or full length pants that the bottoms can be zipped off to make them into shorts</li> <li>• Skirts and tunic dresses need to be modest, knee or slightly above knee in length</li> <li>• Wearing shorts underneath skirts and dresses is recommended but not mandatory</li> <li>• Tunic dresses are blue plaid or solid plain navy blue and worn with plain white/blue collared tops underneath</li> <li>• Kilt from vendor</li> </ul>
<p>Other clothing items include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tights/leggings with skirt &amp; socks</li> <li>• Shoes</li> <li>• Belts</li> <li>• Over-garments: sweaters, hoodies/sweatshirts, cardigans and vests</li> <li>• Tie ( vendor approved)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Girls tights can be plain white or plain navy blue</li> <li>• Socks, that can be seen, can be solid white or solid navy blue</li> <li>• Shoes should be suitable for recess, gym and physical activity – running shoes are recommended, secure sandals when weather appropriate</li> <li>• Belts are optional. Belts can be plain black or navy blue to be worn for the purpose of securing clothing</li> <li>• Indoor over-garments are to be plain navy blue, white or grey</li> </ul>
<b>What is not included or What not to wear</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Denim/jeans, vinyl material like wind pants (outdoor wear)</li> <li>• No leggings as pants</li> <li>• Clothing with visible labels, logos of any size, contrasting colours, coloured buttons or stitching, stripes or detailing</li> <li>• Hats and sunglasses (outdoor wear) in the building</li> <li>• Flip flops and slip on sandals without straps</li> <li>• Mini-skirts, halter-tops, tank tops, muscle shirts, t-shirts with vulgar sayings</li> <li>• Clothing with tears/holes</li> <li>• Oversized clothing (shirts to the knee, pants hanging low and off the waist)</li> </ul>	
<b>Other Details</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Athletic wear is optional</li> <li>• Hair accessories should be subtle and align with dress code</li> <li>▪ Students may be asked to wear spirit wear to school sanctioned events (Cross Country, Swim Meet, Track &amp; Field, etc.)</li> <li>• There is no dress code requirement for student outerwear including jackets, snow pants, hats and gloves</li> <li>• St. Denis Catholic School crests will be available through InSchoolwear Inc. at the school. Crest placement on clothing items should comply with vendor purchased items (For shirts, on the upper left portion of the shirt. For pants or shorts, on the left leg, half way between the knee and waist)</li> <li>• All third colour items (grey) must be purchased from InSchoolwear Inc.</li> </ul>	
<b>Dress Down Days</b>	
<p>During the year, dress down or non-dress code days will be planned. These days will be noted in the school calendar and/or student agendas. Students have the option of wearing the dress code or <i>regular clothes</i> which may include coloured clothing, denim/jeans, and logos. All other guidelines for what is not included should be followed. Students should be modestly dressed in keeping with our Catholic values. Students also have the option of a dress down day on their birthday. If a birthday falls on a weekend or holiday, students will have the option of dressing down on the Friday before.</p>
