1. Opening prayer led by Ms. Costa @ 6:00pm
2. Attendance: Ms. Cilena Costa, Ms. Helen Veloso, Margareth Toste and Ms. Elisa Arciero
3. Approval of Minutes from January 10, 2019. All members present reviewed and approved the minutes.
4. Principal's Report
 - Fr. Francesco visited the Gr. 2s and Gr. 7s on Jan. 16 and Feb. 6
 - Kindergarten registration for September 2019 began on Jan. 16
 - The Lunch Lego Club for the registered Gr. 1s and 2s began on Jan. 17th
 - On Jan. 17th , I booked the MADD Canada presentation for our Gr. 7s and Gr. 8s and the Gr. 3/ 4, Gr. 4, Gr. 5, and Gr. 5/ 6 classes went skating at Caboto Rink
 - Jan. 18th was a PA Day and no school for students – it was an Assessment, Evaluation and Reporting Day
 - On Jan. 22, we practiced the Hold and Secure Drill
 - Fire Safety Presentations took place for all classes on Jan. 22, Jan. 31 and Feb. 4

 - On Jan. 24, Ms. Minnella, Ms. Radovini and I stayed for the Kindergarten evening registration, we had 7 families register that night
 - At this time we have 22 students registered for the first year of the ELP program in Sept. 2019
 - Jan. 25 was our Dress Down Day and we collected \$242.35 for charity
 - The Lunch Lego Club for the registered Gr. 3s and 4s began on Jan. 25th
 - Sunday, January 27th was Family Literacy Day
 - On Jan. 30th , the Gr. 4 students wrote the OLSAT/8 test in the morning
 - Jan. 31st was our January Spirit Day, wear your favourite team jersey
 - Ms. Toste brought both the Intermediate Boys' and the Intermediate Girls' basketball teams to their divisional tournaments on Feb. 5th and Feb. 6th
 - On Feb. 7th , all the classes enjoyed the Canadian Black Heritage presentation by Arts Express based on the book, Sweet Clara and the Freedom Quilt
 - Thank you to our CSPC for funding this presentation
 - Fr. Victor visited the Gr. 3s and Gr. 8s on Feb. 8

- Feb. 11th was the 100th day of school – 11 students have 0 days late and 0 days absent as of Sept. 4/19 – each student received a prize (Frog Game key chain or Squish Balls)
- First Term Report Cards went home on Feb. 11th
- Feb. 12th due to weather conditions, the Board closed the schools

- Feb. 19th Carnival Week began, concert with Njacko Backo (drummer from Cameroon), the Gr. 5 students went to the Legislative Building and Int. Girls' Basketball team competing in 2nd Place Tournament at BM/TM
- The Artificial Turf project for our field has been approved and construction will begin in the Spring of 2019
- Fun Fair will not take place this year because of the construction
- The flyers for our Pro-Grant Events entitled Family Lego Night for the Jr./Int. on Feb. 27th and on Mar. 1st for the Primary students were distributed
- After March Break, I will be offering Northern Karate lessons over the lunch hour for our Gr. 1 to Gr. 4 students
- An opportunity to offer ukulele lessons, drama or cartooning during the lunch hour next year
- I would like to arrange the ukulele lessons for the fall and change up the guitar lessons
