The Toronto Catholic District School Board remains committed to providing your community with a new Kindergarten to Grade 12 facility at the current site of Blessed Trinity Catholic School in the near future.

You are already aware that the Ministry of Education has approved funding for the secondary school portion of this project. TCDSB staff continue to explore funding options for the elementary portion of the proposed new school facility.

The Board is moving forward with appointing an architect in order to begin the design process for the future facility. In addition, signage is forthcoming at both schools announcing to the community the future plans for the K-12 facility. We are hopeful that this will help to spread the good news that a new school will be coming to your neighbourhood.

As we move forward towards the design and approval process with the City of Toronto there will be further opportunity for you to provide input, and we will keep you apprised of our progress. The Board is working towards a completion date of 2014 for the new school building.
