Happy New Year! We, the Catholic School Advisory Council are preparing for our first fundraiser for 2014. The Dance-A-Thon is scheduled for **Friday, February 14, 2014**. The objective of the funds raised will be used to support many educational activities at our school.

The Dance-A-Thon is an activity where the children are encouraged to dance for a specific period of time to the music that is played. Students enjoy a fun varied workout with dance! The benefits of this type of fundraiser are:

## DANCE-A-THON:



- The Dance-A-Thon will take place in our gym, on **Friday, February 14, 2014**.
- Students are encouraged to *wear red and white* in honor of St. Valentine.
- Parents of JK, SK, grade one and two students are more than welcome to attend. The schedule is as follows:

Grade one, two, and three students	9:15 am to 10:25 a.m.
JK/SK students	10:45 am to 11:55 a.m.
Grade four, five, and six students	1:15 pm to 1:55 p.m.
Grade seven and eight students	2:25 pm to 3:25 p.m.

## PRIZES:

- Prizes will be distributed on Friday February 21, 2014 during an assembly and will be based on the monies returned to school by Wednesday February 19, 2014.
- A student can receive only one individual prize and are eligible for the daily draw prizes.
- There will be **SIX GRAND PRIZES** awarded to students that raise the most money.
- A **PIZZA LUNCH** will be offered for each junior and intermediate class that raises \$500.00. (Primary classes that raise \$400.00 will receive a pizza lunch as there are fewer students in these classes). Our school goal is to raise **\$6,000**.
- Each student will obtain a chance to win a prize for each **\$10.00** submitted. A special draw will be held on each collection date(s) as mentioned above – ***the more funds raised the more chances to win***
