## Dress Code in TCDSB Schools

The Toronto Catholic District School Board implemented an Appropriate Dress Code in all of its elementary schools in September 2011.



The Appropriate Dress Code consists of any combination of white and navy blue garments (e.g. **plain** white top, navy blue bottom or, navy blue top and bottom, no denim). *Please note that a "combination of" **does not mean** blue and white shorts or blue and white striped top etc...*

We have noticed that over time the students at St. Vincent de Paul have moved away from the board implemented dress code. To begin the new school year on the right foot, we would like to remind our community of our Do's and Don'ts for the dress code.

Please review the reverse page and dress your child appropriately beginning September 4th, 2018.

We will be adopting a *3 Strikes* approach for infractions from grades K-8.

Process for infractions will be as follows:

- ✗ First dress code infraction: warning slip sent home
- ✗ Second dress code infraction: second warning slip sent home
- ✗ Third dress code infraction: phone call home
- ✗ After the above three warnings, you will be asked to come and take your child home for appropriate clothing or bring them appropriate clothing to change into at school.

## TCDSB Dress Code Do's and Don'ts

## Do's

- ✓ Plain/solid white top
- ✓ Plain/solid navy blue top
- ✓ Navy blue bottom
- ✓ Collar an no collared shirts
- ✓ Navy blue dress or tunic for girls



## Don'ts

- ✗ Denim
- ✗ Combined coloured tops and bottom (blue and white design top)
- ✗ Stripes
- ✗ Other designs/embellishments such as stars, stripes, dots, hearts etc...
- ✗ Logos larger than one square inch
- ✗ No sweatshirts/hoodies in colours other than solid/plain navy or white
