Many of the schools that we compete against train throughout the entire school year, and I would like our students to have the same opportunity.

We will train in High Park and Sorauen Park where students will learn the fundamentals of running and competition and benefit from a fun and supportive training environment, where runners of all abilities can train together to reach

their individual goals. As we are still in cross-county season we will continue to focus on distance running and move into speed and track and field distances as we get closer to spring.
